Staff members will not play in any team event but might be part of the winner's trip. Staff members will be the team manager and assist owner/captain as needed.

Teams will consist of at least four players determined by the team captain. Each team must consist of at least two members with the option of having up to two guests on the team as well. All players, including guests, must have an established golf handicap. Members, guests, and subs can only play for one team.

Golf Format: Each of the four Team Golf Events will have a unique golf format. In each event the 4person team will split into (2) 2-person teams and each 2-person team will compete under the format for that event. The total team score will be the combination of the (2) 2-person team's scores. In each event 2-person teams will be paired separately with other competing 2-person teams. Team owners do not have to play in all four events and monthly team members are interchangeable.

Entry fee includes the following:
